Word Youth Day 2023

World Youth Day (WYD) is the gathering of young people from all over the world with the Pope. It is also a pilgrimage, a celebration of youth, an expression of the universal Church and an intense moment of evangelization for the youth world. Although its Catholic identity is clearly evident, WYD opens its doors to everyone.

It aims to provide all participants with a universal Church experience, fostering a personal encounter with Jesus Christ. World Youth Day also seeks to promote peace, unity and fraternity among peoples and nations around the world.

In 1984, the Pope St. John Paul II decided to organize a gathering on Palm Sunday, in Rome, to celebrate the Youth Jubilee of the Holy Year of Redemption 1983-1984. The more universal World Youth Day was the fruit of this very popular local gathering.

Next summer, World Youth Day 2023 will take place in Lisbon, Portugal from August 1-6. Both the Archdioceses of Winnipeg and St. Boniface are planning a joint pilgrimage group of about 35 or so young adults to participate in WYD 2023, as well as the pre-WYD event called, "Days in the Diocese", where they will have more opportunity to meet other nations and get to experience the local church and host region. The "Days in the Diocese" will take place in Portimao, Portugal, about 2 hours away from Lisbon, and will be from July 26-31.

I myself am hoping and planning to join the pilgrimage group for WYD 2023. I have greatly desired to attend previous ones but things never seemed to work out. Next summer may be different. Please pray for me and the other pilgrims who are discerning participation. Catechists

Our parish's catechism and sacramental prep programs have undergone some radical transformations over the past two years as a result of the pandemic. 2020-2021 we shifted to mainly virtual through the development of a new website of lessons and resources to help parents ensure their children could continue growing in their faith journey, despite the inability for in-person catechesis. There were many good fruits of this with regard to parents and families intentionally making time and space for faith and family time in the home and growing together. 2021-2022 we once again adapted to the circumstances by allowing families to continue the online and virtual catechesis and sacramental prep while also fitting in some in-person lessons because the social element of our faith and human nature is of great importance. For both these years, we would like to thank both the parents, who are the primary religious educators of their children, and the very generous catechism volunteers who have helped these past two years.

This coming year of catechism and sacramental prep for 2022-2023 once again offers us the opportunity to review the new circumstances we find ourselves in and discern the best way to pass on our faith to the younger generations, helping them to encounter our Blessed Lord in their own lives and develop a lifelong relationship. We expect to have over 50 young people in various grades register for the coming Fall season and we have a desire to return to in-person classes once again at the church. To do this though, we require generous disciples who are willing to share their own relationship and faith with others as catechists, along with other adults who would support the programs with their presence and assistance.

This year is the Year of Service, so perhaps God may be calling you to serve the young people of our parish by helping them to encounter and know our Good Shepherd, Jesus Christ. 


THE WILD GOOSE: GOD'S LOVE POURED OUT


